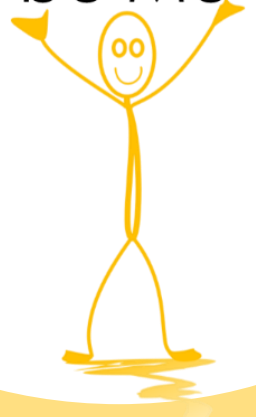




# Learning Letter
